SWAG DADDY stalked the front runners from the three path, was already under some urging turning for home, went at it head to head with the second place finisher for a furlong, commencing from the three-sixteenths pole before edging away late under good handling. THEWIZARDOFNASSAU off the inside, prompted the pacesetter for the initial half, advanced to issue his bid nearing the five-sixteenths pole, wrested away the lead from a more much energetically-handled opponent, had no sooner achieved the front when put to the test himself by the eventual winner, raced as a team only inches apart from upper stretch to about a sixteenth to go, fell back steadily at that point but finished willingly nonetheless to secure second. THINK I'M HOOKED coaxed along giving chase near the two path, lacked the necessary stretch response. JETER inward a step a step leaving the starting gate, was pulled off the nearest rival, raced along the outside, was asked for some run by the five-sixteenths pole, swung four wide into upper stretch, failed to gain ground appreciably. GOSSIP COLUMN ducked over to the rail during the run around the bend, was under a drive cutting the corner into the lane, came up empty. MISSILEWHILEUWORK cut the pace from the inside, was put to strong encouragement, yet succumbed to the runner up's bid nearing the end of the turn. SKY COLORS broke awkwardly, faded off a ground-saving journey.
