CAY TO POMEROY broke alertly, was under a firm hold darting over to the inside, felt up an uptick in the pressure heading for the top of the lane, responded when given his cue and remained comfortably in front. LEILANI'S TICKET chased the winner from the two path on the bend, initially between rivals, failed to keep up in the stretch but was still second best. CRAFTY DREAMER saved ground and held the show. REGGIE D three wide at the top of the turn, swung outward until in the six path by end of the furlong grounds, could only muster up a mild kick. LUXURY APPEAL at or near the two path, made no serious moves. SPORTSWRITER raced three wide on the turn and had no rally. AMBASSADOR BRIDGE rode the rail down the backstretch, left the eighth pole eight wide, came up empty. G W'S HAMMER prompted from the two path and gave way. QUIET MIRACLE took the inside route on the turn to no avail. MEET THE METS four wide departing the backstretch, tired. WESTERN GRIT well off the rail, got pulled up after getting eased and

subsequently walked off the track.
