TWO NAMES raced close up along the inside while in hand, split rivals in upper stretch, dug in gamely and drew clear late under a drive. TEN BOLTS raced close up outside, rallied three wide nearing the stretch and finished gamely outside. SEEKNFIND raced inside early on, came wide for the drive and finished well outside. SWEET SEPTEMBER raced close up inside, was steadied along the inside on the turn, rallied inside into the stretch, altered course in the drive and finished well. SUNSHINE HELEN was outrun early, rallied four wide on the turn and finished well. FORT CARILLON was outrun early, rallied wide and finished well while racing greenly. HOLY BRIDLE contested the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. FAMILIAR SONG was outrun early, raced between rivals and had no rally. MOYA raced three wide and had no rally. ROYAL SPAULDING contested the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch.
