PRETTY B reserved during the opening stages, steadily advanced into a good striking position departing the backstretch, continued the bid while placed four wide at the three-eighths pole, took charge during the run through the furlong grounds and edged clear while being kept busy. ARSENAL outrun for nearly a half, ranged up to the front runners on the second turn, swung three wide into the stretch and was along in time to win the place photo. CURLINA underwent a wide journey and was outfinished. MORDECAI JONES the early trailer, began a long march into contention from the four path, initially in hand, then while being lightly urged along coming to the five-sixteenths pole, swung a bit wider into the lane and held well to the wire. KAFFIEND quickly established command, showed the way from the two path on a loosely-contested lead, came under pressure in upper stretch, succumbed, then tired steadily while laboring during the last eighth. MERLOT DREAMS was through after completing three-quarters. COUGAR CRUISE never reached a contending position, and was eased turning for home. ATALAYA accompanied the pacesetter to the quarter pole before fading. MYTHICAL YARN ducked towards the inside at the half mile, tired and was eased in the stretch. KEITH'S KITTEN well off the inside and always outrun, was eased turning for home.
