BLANK CHECK ducked in sharply at the break, recovered and moved up to assume a forward position, tracked the leader from the pocket under a firm hold, made a bid when ready approaching the quarter pole, entered the stretch with a clear lead, and having now been asked for a response, increased the lead during the ensuing furlong, then successfully fended off the determined runner up while being kept to the task at hand. STARSHIP SCOTT unhurried for nearly a half, was four wide when roused coming to the three-eighths pole, finished with good courage during the stretch run to garner place honors. SAINT DAIMON bumped lightly with TAR BEACH at the break, went on to grab the early lead, was rated in the two path facing only mild pressure for almost three-quarters, was called upon when put to the test by the top one, failed to keep pace with that rival, succumbing readily, but held well enough during the last eighth to procure the show. TIMELESS CLASSIC was guided over to the rail after clearing a fading rival at the three-eighths pole, took the inside thereafter but failed to deliver a solid stretch offering after being called upon. TAR BEACH lightly bumped between rivals at the start, chased for a half and gave way. SAWTOOTH MOUNTAIN raced along the outside and failed to reach a contending position. STOPBLUFFING lightly bumped at the start, was outrun. WEB GEM lunged at the start, underwent a wide journey, was eased in upper stretch, and walked across the finish line to earn the final check.
