FASTUS CACTUS broke alertly from the gate and was quickly in front, herded a trio outward a significant amount of ground during the early run down the backstretch, was gathered in hand and soon maneuvered closer to the rail, sped off from the competition under a firm hold and well off the inside during the run around the bend, held his biggest advantage turning for home, began to shorten stride noticeably in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, was put to periodic encouragement during the last eighth pole and managed to hold sway. IN JUST WE TRUST away from the gate in good order, was herded out several paths by the top one shortly after the break, was taken in hand and eased back a bit to escape the predicament, gradually worked his way over to the three path, chased the leader from afar three wide around the turn, was set down turning for home, gained readily on the weakening winner during the stretch run, but had to settle for being second best. SENSATIONALIST was one of three horses carried out soon after leaving the starting gate, raced unhurried while deliberately kept off the inside, swung four wide coming to the five-sixteenths pole after being asked for some run, finished well enough to be along for the show, although posing no threat to top twosome at any point in the lane. NEW YAWKER urged along in attempt to keep pace, saved ground until the quarter pole and bested the rest. WILD ENTRY (JPN) outrun for a half, swung four wide into the lane but lacked a solid response. MORETHANATALE tired after a half. COPS FEVER off a beat slowly, was coaxed along, but was never in the hunt. HILLSWICK was carried out several paths by the winner shortly after the start, found room to be guided towards the inside by midpoint on the backstretch, gave chase but was through after completing a half.
