KID WANDO broke alertly and grabbed a narrow early advantage, took up residence in the two path shortly afterwards and argued to maintain the lead, was put to a drive leading the field into the lane, dug in well to prove best. THE MIXER taken over to the inside coming to the end of the backstretch, bided time early on the turn when positioned a slight distance behind RED JACK, had that rival vacate the inside route about midway on the turn, went on little further down the road and was roused, cut the corner under a drive and with good momentum, came home willingly to procure the place. TERMINUS pressed the issue from the three path, got called upon after settling into upper stretch, held on well to take the show. RED JACK left the inside at the three-eighths pole, was already under encouragement spinning into the lane, got outfinished. MY MAN DAN saved ground and lacked the needed response. EXCITING MISSILE raced from off the inside and had no rally. FEAR NOTHING chased three wide on the turn, folded. WARRIOR FROM ABOVE three wide entering the turn, was under active handling exiting it four wide, came up empty. EL CORRIENTE leapt up at the start, raced along the outside and was outrun. TARDY coaxed in the two path while giving chase on the turn, was through after going a half. ALTERNATIVE swung five wide into upper stretch with no offering to give.
