Footnotes

FLAT OUT sat well reserved from off the inside, was asked to pick up the pace during the later stages of the run around the far turn, swung three wide into upper stretch and took off in earnest after the front runners, gained ground readily during the ensuing furlong, continued onward relentlessly, grabbing away the advantage in the final stride. STAY THIRSTY was put to light hand urging leaving the starting gate and grabbed the early advantage, cut the pace, rated along the inside and facing resistance from at least two others, although not the same pair, until the five-sixteenths pole, turned for home with FORT LARNED directly alongside and with the eventual winner slightly to their outside lurking for the initial time as a danger, held his ground well from upper to midstretch, came under heavy pressure from the top one soon afterwards, displayed gameness to the end, but got nipped. FORT LARNED was forwardly placed four wide until the half mile pole, took over from RULER ON ICE to press the issue as the widest of three at the top of the second turn, went at it one on one with STAY THIRSTY once SAN PABLO began to tire a short distance from the quarter pole, remained a prominent factor until midstretch before giving way. ATIGUN raced along the outside and lacked the needed response. FAST FALCON between rivals on the far turn, was driven four wide into the stretch, flattened out. RON THE GREEK taken to the rail at the end of the backstretch, failed to fire when called upon for the stretch run. GAME BALL rode the rail until the half mile pole, was fanned six wide into upper stretch, made no impact. HYMN BOOK three wide around both turns, folded. SAN PABLO strung out three wide making his way towards the backstretch, contested the pace as the widest of three while advancing towards the far turn, continued to vie with two others, but only now from the two path and from between opponents until the five-sixteenths marker, tired steadily thereafter. RULER ON ICE was given a few shakes of the rein by the pilot and hustled up into a forward position, vied from between rivals down the backstretch until the vicinity of the half mile pole, fell back slightly then became choppy-gaited as he made a hasty retreat to become the trailer by the quarter pole, left that station under a protective hold and got eased.
