STORMY LEN assumed a forward position in the initial stages, showed the way from the two path facing some but relatively light pressure, had the pressure intensify just prior to turning for home, was a short distance into the stretch drive before getting asked for some run himself, lost little if any of the advantage making his way through the furlong grounds, saw the margin dwindle down steadily thereafter but showed enough determination while being kept busy to the end to prevail. FOR GREATER GLORY chased the winner three wide on the turn, was set down a few strides before reaching the quarter pole, made no headway from upper to midstretch, gained ground steadily thereafter en route for the place. MIDNITE POPPA drafted behind the winner early on the turn, was put to some urging and ducked over to the sparsely occupied inside route at midpoint, continued to stay within range of the front runners, was already under some encouragement cutting the corner into the lane, remained along the inside route throughout the ensuing furlong altered course outward one lane once things appeared less promising, had the two path likewise shut down enough to encourage a second altering of course at the sixteenth pole, continued onward well enough for the show, although getting outfinished by the top twosome. MAKE YOUR MOVE rode the rail, was urged cutting the corner into the lane, had no gain. TOWN EXTENSION raced along the outside, was placed to a long hard drive, proved no match. THUNDER QUAY carried in slightly at the start, was no threat. STEVLAND off the inside, swung six wide by the three-sixteenths pole, had no rally. FREEDOM CHILD put to encouragement, unleashed a four wide run on the turn, was flattening out shortly before arriving at the quarter pole. BATTLE STRIKE saved ground to no avail. CAPTAIN EASY three wide at the half mile pole, was under a drive a sixteenth later, tired.
