DADDY'S LIL SAINT raced three wide on the turn,,was slightly wider entering the stretch, closed in, grabbed away the lead in the last seventy yards and kicked away. INSTRUMENTAL underwent a three wide pursuit on the turn, came home with good energy to procure the place. SHERIFFA chased the front runners mostly from the two path on the turn, fanned extremely wide travelling through the furlong grounds until seven to eighth wide by its end, closed in with late foot en route for the show. SKYE SARATOGA left a tardy post parade early to get a proper warm up, assumed a forward position after the start, patiently stalked the leader from the two path for the initial half, responded well when asked for room to cut into the gap readily making his way from the top of the lane to mid lane, flattened out late. PEACH LAKE saved ground on the turn, and rallied mildly to mainly improve position. MARY'S IN UTOPIA carried inward by an errant MARGARET OWNZIT at the break, raced along the outside and was no menace. LADY RHUBARB rated inside to the quarter pole, yielded in the final furlong and faltered. MARGARET OWNZIT broke inward, sat loosely pocketed and had no response. UNDER SCRUTINY three wide at the midway point on the turn, was never in contention. SHADES OF INDYGO saved ground to no avail. STORMIN MARY along the inside and roused at the three-eighths pole, came up empty.
