FOR FILLIES TWO YEARS OLD. No nomination fee. \$2,000 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination payment of \$4,000 in addition to the entry fee can be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$1,000 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. The owner of any two year old who has broken its maiden in a race at the Aqueduct Spring or Belmont Spring/Summer meetings is eligible for a one time bonus of \$100,000 that will count toward the horses earnings if that horse goes on to win a graded sweepstake at any NYRA track in 2013. 121 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 allowed 2 lbs.; a race, 4 lbs.; maidens, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter and restricted allowance races not considered in allowances.) A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, September 14, 2013 with 24 Nominations.

MISS BEHAVIOUR made light contact with QUEEN BOULEVARD at the start, moved up willingly to become the primary pursuer, challenged the leader coming to the midway point on the turn, went by and edged away from a more energetically-handled opponent soon afterwards, turned for home comfortably in the clear, got set down and responded positively to the encouragement, held her biggest lead between the quarter pole and the furlong marker, had it chopped down readily by SWEET WHISKEY in the last eighth, but was kept going well enough long enough to prevail. SWEET WHISKEY broke alertly and was sent over to the inside, was put to solid encouragement as the winner made her move nearing the three-eighths pole, yielded nonetheless and steadily lost contact during the rest of the way to the quarter pole, was angled outward during the drive home, gained ground late. GRACER three wide departing the backstretch, fell back steadily during the run around the bend despite racing around it being urged along, commenced the stretch still placed in three path, showed some belatedly foot en route for the show. COURT DANCER under a firm in the early stages, was taken off the inside route after halfway around the bend, spun into the stretch and lacked the needed response. OCEAN BOULEVARD bumped lightly with the winner at the start, darted over to the rail, failed to menace off the subsequent ground-saving journey. ART OF THE GAME two wide entering the turn, was in the three path exiting it, tired.
