GINO'S SPIRITS (GB) raced close up inside while under wraps, found a clear path along the rail in upper stretch, quickly moved through and drew clear under a drive. LA VILLE ROUGE was outrun along the inside early on, swung wide entering the stretch and finished gamely outside to get the place. SOLAR BOUND was rated along early, rallied four wide nearing the stretch and stayed on well to the finish. FICTITIOUS (GB) chased the pace while three wide and weakened in the final furlong. BABAE (CHI) argued the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. LURICON was rated outside, raced wide and had no response when roused. SPOOK EXPRESS (SAF) chased the pace while between rivals and tired in the stretch. STORM DREAM (IRE) argued the pace from the outside and tired after three quarters.
