SHESASTONECOLDFOX quickly opened a clear lead, set the pace, drew away in the stretch and was kept to a drive to the wire. PRINCESS DIXIE was outrun early, raced inside and rallied on the rail to get the place award. DANCING BLUES chased the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. WHATABOUTUS showed speed inside, was checked along the rail on the backstretch, raced inside and had no rally. LIVE BAND chased the pace while between rivals and tired after a half mile. STORM DREAM raced wide and drifted while tiring in the stretch. MEADOW LOVE chased outside and tired in the stretch. OUR BREADWINNER chased the pace while four wide and tired. QUEEN OF SARATOGA tired after showing brief speed.
