Footnotes

SHAREHOLDER DUES raced in hand early, was under a firm hold along the rail while awaiting room on the turn, raced in traffic entering the stretch, split horses to get clear in upper stretch and drew off under steady right hand urging. PEACEFIELDS moved up from outside to threaten on the turn, gained a slim lead in midstretch and held well to best the others. WE GET IT lodged a four wide move to reach contention on the turn and finished evenly. MACHO MAMBO set the pace along the inside into upper stretch and weakened. VAMEL steadied in traffic on the backstretch, advanced four wide on the turn and flattened out. EDDIE'S POINT failed to threaten after breaking slowly. CANTONIC raced up close between horses for a half and steadily tired thereafter. FRANKLIN DELANO pressed the pace along the inside to the turn and gave way.
