STELLALUCE disputed the pace three wide, issued a successful challenge to take over in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, drew out to a sizeable advantage when asked for run from upper stretch to the eighth pole, added to it, crossing the wire under mild hand encouragement. FIRST PENNY hustled away from the starting gate, was taken hold once things became a bit too crowded on the front end, underwent a four wide pursuit, was asked to pick up the pace nearing the end of the run around the bend, proved no match for the winner after entering the stretch. LADY OF THE FOREST argued for command from the two path, got confronted by the winner arriving at the five-sixteenths pole, yielded readily despite being put to a drive and faded. AIR MAIL devoid of early foot, swung three wide into upper stretch, flashed some speed belatedly to improve position. DOES IT EVERY TIME saved ground and faltered. PAT'S MEOW was put to a right handed whip leaving the gate for naught, raced along the outside and was outrun.
