Footnotes

PISTOLS AT DAWN broke well to secure the lead, was gradually taken over towards the inside with the runner up shadowing the move, tucked along the rail shortly before leaving the backstretch, argued with IRON LOU during the run around the bend, was let out a notch and kicked away to a comfortable advantage, held sway, crossing the wire under hand encouragement. IRON LOU sparred with the winner while racing along the outside, had to settle for being second best. I AIN'T NO SAINT well placed off the disputed pace, was urged from the three path into the stretch, proved no match for the top twosome. FINE FLYER received intermittent attention from the rider on the right shoulder proceeding down the backstretch, saved ground and was through after going a half. CORONATION DAY three to four wide on the turn, gave way. PAVORATTI'S SOUL three wide departing the backstretch, folded. JUDGE WELL off the inside, trailed throughout.
