Footnotes

WRITETHATDOWN away well, tucked briefly into the pocket just past the half mile pole, was placed back in the two path shortly afterwards once JAZZBO ranged up to contest the pace, narrowed in late on the turn, angled three wide into upper stretch and took off in earnest, crept up to the front runners during the stretch run, grabbed the lead in deep stretch and edged away. LAST OUT OF PANAMA bumped at the start, was unhurried for nearly three-quarters, was under a drive spinning from the four path into the stretch, came home willingly to secure second. RESEARCH REPORT vied between rivals for command from the half mile pole to the five-sixteenths pole, held on well for third. RUMBLETOWN placed under an early snug hold, was guided over to the rail shortly after leaving the chute, came under heavy pressure upon reaching the turn, forced to argue for command with two rivals, doing so until the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, got set down at that station to keep up the fight, turned for home and steadily weakened. CAPTAIN BUZZBEE got bumped at the start, was already encouragement cutting the corner into the lane, lacked the necessary stretch response. JAZZBO three wide departing the backstretch, was the widest of a threesome vying for the lead throughout much of the run around the bend, fell back after entering the stretch. TERROX was never in the hunt.
