BIG GRANDPA set the pace from just off the inside, had the field spread out well in behind through the turn, came under rousing straightening for home, edged clear to the furlong grounds under a drive, came under mild hand urging inside the final sixteenth with the outcome no longer in doubt. CATALAN chased three wide in close range, got ridden along from the five-sixteenths, proved no match for the top one through the stretch while well clear for the place and second best. POWER BLAST chased just off the inside, got set down at the head of the stretch, offered up a mild kick for the show honors in the late stages. METAURUS urged three wide towards the rear, got set down in earnest at the five-sixteenths, drifted out under strong near sided stick work while kicking on belatedly for the last major share. HOLY CRUSADER in pursuit while three wide in midpack, got set down at the five-sixteenths, weakened in the final eighth. FISCAL STIMULUS tracked just off the pace, came under urging midway on the turn and tired after a half. SIETE MACHOS saved ground to no avail from towards the rear when offering no response when called upon at the five-sixteenths. POSTPONE taken in hand after the start, chased four wide towards the rear under a prolonged drive from the seven-sixteenths, never factored then was not persevered with in the final eighth.
