GUYANA PRINCESS squeezed back after being brushed from both sides at the break, dropped back considerably after getting steadied by the rider, was guided over to the rail, was put to hand urging and began to settle into stride soon afterwards, unleashed a strong run during the run around the bend to dramatically cut into the gap, swung four wide into the stretch, altered course slightly inward and split rivals through a large opening approaching the sixteenth pole, drew off, under solid hand encouragement. STELLARS THEORY pressed the issue from the outside, was called upon for the stretch drive, gained a narrow advantage despite taking an erratic course down the lane, zigzagging a few paths at a time during intervals, proved powerless to turn back the winner with about a sixteenth to go, held on well though for the place. BLONDECAT brushed at the start, rode the rail, was put to solid encouragement by midpoint on the turn, angled outward in midstretch and was along for the show. TIGER GIRL argued to maintain a slight advantage from the rail until the furlong grounds before giving way. ROCK STAR ROYALTY brushed at the start, raced along the outside, got put to encouragement after halfway around the turn, tired. CHEROKEE TRICK coaxed along while keeping up with pace combatants, folded. SYSTEM READY three wide at the half mile pole, was through after going a half.
