MARGIN FOR ERROR lacked a rally. PRINCESS JUBILEE raced inside and had no rally. PEACH MELBA, bumped at the start, had no response when roused. MY SAINTED AUNT chased inside and tired. MAYICUTIN tired after a wide trip. STANLEY'S COMET broke awkwardly and was outrun.
