EVER A FRIEND was hustled to the front, set the pace along the inside and drew away when roused. SUNRIVER raced close up along the inside, altered course to the outside in the stretch and rallied to get the place. SAINT DAIMON raced close up outside, rallied four wide on the turn, lugged in in the stretch and was outfinished for the place. CAMARGO ROAD was outrun along the inside early, angled out in upper stretch and offered a mild rally outside. ABSOLUTE RETURN chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. DE ROODE stumbled at the start, raced wide and had no rally. MINER'S LAMP raced between rivals and tired after a half mile. PATRIOT GAME raced inside and tired. SENOR ORTIZ chased the pace from the outside and tired.
