Footnotes

TASTE OF PARADISE was outrun early, rallied along the inside into the stretch, angled out approaching the eighth pole, ran by the leaders a sixteenth out and was clear under the wire, driving. TIGER HEART was hustled up inside, rallied nearing the stretch, gained a short lead at the eighth pole and dug in gamely to hold the place. LION TAMER was outrun early, advanced inside turning for home, altered course in deep stretch and was coming fast at the finish. SILVER WAGON was bumped at the start, dropped back early, raced inside and finished gamely on the rail. I'M THE TIGER showed good speed outside, chased the pace, rallied three wide into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. MASS MEDIA was outrun early, raced four wide and managed a mild rally outside. UNFURL THE FLAG was hustled along outside, chased the pace and had no response when roused. POMEROY was outrun early, came wide for the drive and had no response when roused. WOKE UP DREAMIN chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. UNCLE CAMIE stumbled at the start, was bumped, was hustled out to a clear lead, set the pace and tired in the stretch.
