ASHADO broke running, pressed the pace from the outside while in hand, took the lead after the opening three quarters, drew clear when roused in upper stretch then dug in resolutely and held off HAPPY TICKET under a steady drive. HAPPY TICKET was urged along inside early, advanced inside nearing the stretch, angled off the rail in upper stretch and finished gamely outside. SOCIETY SELECTION was urged along outside, put in a four wide run on the turn and weakened in the final furlong. SWEET SYMPHONY was hustled along early, raced between rivals and had no response when roused. PERSONAL LEGEND raced close up outside early, chased the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. DREAM OF SUMMER was hustled to the front, set the pace along the inside and tired after three quarters. ISLAND SAND was outrun early, raced wide and had no response when roused.
