MISSISSIPPI DUEL settled into the pocket soon after the start, patiently tracked the ongoing pace dispute, was let out a notch early on the turn, advanced to challenge for command at the five-sixteenths pole, grabbed a short lead and was let out turning for home, emerged from the eighth pole holding his biggest advantage, displayed some green ness swerving in and out during the next sixteenth, resumed a straighter course thereafter and held on. WILD EXPLOIT unhurried for much of the opening half, swung from the four path into the stretch, came home with good energy to secure second. PARACHUTE CONEY assumed a forward position leaving the starting gate, sat entrenched in the two path, argued for command with another pair until late on the turn, failed to stave off the top one's challenge, but held well enough to earn the show. MIKE AND ROB received some attention on the right shoulder but was out hustled nonetheless, lagged behind for nearly three-quarters, rallied mildly past mainly and tired ones to take the last major check. CURRENT AQUASITION saved ground and flattened out. LONE STAR GOLD broke near the end of the field, moved up willingly into midpack, sat reserved for the initial six furlongs, was under encouragement turning for home five wide, remained a prominent factor for an additional furlong before backing away. WILLY BEAMIN lacked the necessary stretch response. COROFIN came five into upper stretch, had no rally. JACKIN MY STYLE broke alertly to take up a forward spot, fought noticeably on the left side of the bit, perched four wide, under a snug hold, disputing the pace with another twosome, kept up that pursuit for just over five furlongs and tired. THE TAPINATOR four wide at the five-sixteenths pole, folded. AMPERSAND bobbed at the break, was hustled along to secure a forward position, pressed the issue between rivals for the opening six furlongs, retreated.
