Footnotes

INDY SEA broke well conceding the lead to his inside rival, tracked that one from just off the inside, came under mild hand urging midway around the turn, was put to a stiffer drive just past the quarter pole getting by the pacesetter just in the final eighth being kept busy to the end. SILVER MAX broke well and established command while saving ground just off the rail, was in hand and reserved until the five-sixteenths when the rider commenced some light coaxing to draw away from his closest pursuer, was fully roused at the eighth pole and fought well, holding all but the winner at bay while securing the place. LIGHT OF TRUTH broke inward at the start bumping LURE OF THE SOUTH soundly, tracked while well settled in midpack, came under a prolonged drive that commenced at the five-sixteenths pole and steadily gained to procure the show. NILE RUNNER brushed the gate on his left side at the start getting off a tad slow, settled towards the back through the first half and was asked to pick it up nearing the midway point on the turn, responded readily gaining steadily late. TRUMPET MAN bumped at the start with LURE OF THE SOUTH as part of a twosome who sandwiched that rival, tracked while in reserve four wide throughout, came under a drive nearing the quarter pole and offered a mild response. LURE OF THE SOUTH sandwiched at the start between rivals, continued near the back of the pack while saving ground around the turn, came under a drive nearing midway on the turn, angled out three wide at the head of the lane and tired. NEVER ON TIME well held early while tracking the leader, continued three wide around the turn, came under a drive into the lane and tired. UR off a bit slow, saved ground throughout and was no factor. BALANCE THE BUDGET bobbed at the break and ducked in shortly thereafter, saved ground throughout while being outrun.
