CAPE BLANCO (IRE) was taken off the hedge soon after the start, sat patiently parked in the two path keeping a watchful eye on the pacesetter, continued along on the same scenario until nearing the half mile pole, moved when ready requiring some encouragement to work his way to the front before completing the next furlong, turned for home with a clear advantage and under a strong drive, with the runner up presenting himself a potential danger a short distance to the outside at this juncture drifted outward a couple of paths after a barrage of left handed shots in midstretch, had the rider switch back to the opposite side, saw the margin dwindle down steadily departing the furlong grounds, but dug in stubbornly to preserve the decision. DEAN'S KITTEN took up position well before reaching the first turn, sat a patient pocket until eased outward in the vicinity of the three-eighths pole, settling to be three wide a sixteenth down the road, turned for home and was asked for a response, forged on ahead, cutting gamely into the winner's lead, only to be denied. GRASSY was lightly bumped at the start, swung three wide into the backstretch, was asked to pick up the pace at the half mile pole, failed to respond. MISSION APPROVED easily out broke the field to establish control, showed the way well rated, succumbed when confronted by the top one nearing the end of the backstretch, tired steadily thereafter. WINCHESTER made light contact with GRASSY leaving the starting gate, was kept off the inside and failed to reach a contending position.
