DEFER contested the pace along the inside, responded when roused, drew away and was kept busy to the wire. BACHELOR'S GULCH bobbled at the start, was outrun early, rallied four wide on the turn and continued on gamely to the finish, getting the nod for the place. APPRENTICE raced greenly early on, rallied five wide on the turn and finished gamely outside. SIR HALORY raced inside early on, came wide into the stretch, altered course to the inside and finished gamely. OUR FRIEND TIMMY was outrun early, put in a run along the inside on the turn and had little left for the stretch drive. ARGENTO contested the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. WORTH SEE'N was outrun early, raced inside and had no rally. BASTILLE had no response when roused. LAST SAMURAI raced close up inside, was steadied along the inside on the turn and dropped back. BIRD OF PARADISE tired after a half mile. EIGHT TEN SPECIAL tired after showing brief speed. FOUR DOLLAR LIMIT was finished early.
