Footnotes

YA GOTTA HAVE SOUL away well from the starting gate, assumed a good forward position, drafted behind the pacesetter from the two path and under a good hold, tipped off that opponent at the five-sixteenths pole, came three wide into the stretch, was put to a vigorous drive after being straightened away, gradually made up ground, continued onward leaving the furlong grounds, wrested command in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole and drew away, while remaining under busy handling to the end. BANK HEIST sprinted clear from the competition leaving the starting gate, while well in hand, set the fractions towards the two path, under a firm hold and facing only token pressure from the two nearest pursuers, was let out a notch approaching the head of the stretch, with the top one starting to rev up as well, clung to the advantage displaying good determination during the ensuing furlong, relinquished the lead with a sixteenth to go, but continued on to the wire with good courage to be clearly second best. LAUNCH N RELAUNCH saved ground during the opening stages, was taken outward at the half mile pole, gradually angled outward during the run around the bend, settling into the four path by the five-sixteenths pole, had a mild rally to be along for the show. FRENCHONIONSOUP tracked the pacesetter from the pocket until the top of the lane and tired. YES I'M CLEVER took the inside route from the nine-sixteenths pole to the quarter pole, was asked for a response at the three-eighths pole but could not muster up the needed kick. CORNERSTONE three wide at the three-eighths pole, gave way. WAKE MAKER chased three wide and folded.
