Footnotes

HAYNESFIELD away in good order, quickly established command, was snugly rated on a clear lead towards the two path during the run down the backstretch, spurred away from his closest competitors leaving the half mile, easily opening things up completely under his own courage, entered the stretch leading by a decisive margin, and with the rider having kept plenty in reserve, lengthened away during the ensuing furlong, had the rider take a quick peek back at both the furlong marker and the sixteenth pole, and having sensed no danger in sight, sat chilly as his advantage dwindled down, completing the race a handy winner. BLAME reserved early along the outside, was put to a prolonged drive, swung four wide into the stretch, having now been fully called upon, closed the gap late on a very confidently-handled winner en route to garnering place honors. FLY DOWN unhurried for nearly a mile, fanned five wide into the lane, and rallied mildly to earn the show. HOLD ME BACK patiently tracked the leader from the pocket until nearing the half mile pole, lost contact with that one despite being roused, had little left to offer after turning for home. RAIL TRIP assumed a forward position leaving the starting gate, chased the winner three wide, was called upon for run entering the far turn, but failed to keep up with the pacesetter nonetheless, tired steadily after entering the stretch. TRANQUIL MANNER outrun for a mile, swung wide into the stretch, settled into the five path at the top of lane, failed to deliver a solid stretch offering after being called upon.
