COLIZEO entered the turn from the four path, sat poised from there under a firm hold, crept up to the front runners nearing the five-sixteenths pole, was stacked four wide turning for home, still well in reserve, responded positively when given his cue after being straightened away, took charge by the time he reached the eighth pole and drew away while being kept busy to the end. STORMY'S MAJESTY away alertly, was allowed to drop back into midpack, stalked the early pace activity towards the two path, and with the rider applying a firm hold, was forced to remain on hold, stuck behind a wall spread out four deep in front, found sufficient room to angle sharply five wide into the lane, finished with good energy during stretch run to garner place honors. OUR DARK KNIGHT disputed the pace with his stable mate from the inside, proceeded to weaken during the final eighth. CALLIDE VALLEY took the overland route on the turn and lacked a solid kick. BROTHER BIRD well placed three wide off the pace dispute, made a brief bid between rivals at the five-sixteenths pole before backing off. JACKSON BEND dueled from the two path with OUR DARK KNIGHT until upper stretch and gave way. KEEP ME INFORMED off a bit awkwardly, swung five wide into the stretch but had no rally.
