PRAETEREO slow to settle into stride picked up interest nearing the end of the backstretch, unleashed a four wide run to reach a good striking position by the quarter pole, all done with the barest of encouragement from the rider, bid for command the widest of the three front runners, fought his way to the lead with an eighth to go and kicked clear under good handling. SAM SPARKLE prompted the pacesetter from the outside, moved up to apply more pressure coming to the five-sixteenths pole, was called for some run challenging in earnest between rivals nearing the head of the stretch, grabbed a slim advantage soon afterwards but with the top one in hot pursuit, fell back a head behind by the furlong marker, but was kept going well enough long enough to secure second. TRUELEE SCRAPPIN unhurried in the two path for nearly six furlongs, rallied mildly to miss the place. SELF CONTROL chased three wide, was under a drive entering the stretch, lacked the needed response. E. H. INDY was taken hold early and allowed to ease back, rode the pocket for the opening three-quarters, failed to fire when called upon in upper stretch. CALL FIRST needed some urging leaving the gate to reach the front, was guided over to the rail in time for the run around the bend, came under heavy pressure leaving the five-sixteenths pole, gave in readily after turning for home and weakened. CARRINGTON VILLAGE reserved in midpack along the outside, had no rally. FACTUM well off the inside, trailed.
