BELIEVE YOU CAN perched three wide just behind a disputed pace, advanced into a good striking position nearing the quarter pole, spun the widest of the three front runners and got set down, fought tenaciously making her way to the eighth pole to strike the front, edged away from there under brisk handling. PERENNIAL SONG broke alertly, went head to head with SELECT CAT for the opening sixteenth before put to a snug hold and eased back slightly, remained latched on to the aforementioned rival's side, was let out a notch leaving the half mile pole and eagerly took up the fight a second time, commencing from the seven-sixteenths pole, poked a head in front turning for home and had no sooner done so when hooked up by the winner, showed some true grit before yielding with about an eighth remaining, continued onward with good courage to be second best. GEORGIE'S ANGEL inward a step at the break, was pulled off the nearest opponent before any contact could be made, sat well spotted in the two path, coaxed along to keep pace off the ongoing speed duel, came up empty when called upon for the stretch drive. COLORMESAICHI took the inside route until the quarter pole, angled three wide into upper stretch, had no offering to render. SELECT CAT raced along the inside, was involved in two head to head skirmishes with the runner up during the opening half, gave way.
