CABO CAT raced two wide, between rivals for much of the way to the quarter pole, was guided inward after the runner up had abandoned the inside route at that station, cut the corner being encouraged and made good progress on the front runners, had the rally come to a halt by the end of the run through the furlong grounds, was forced to bide time stuck in traffic for the next sixteenth, gained room to maneuver, courtesy of LITTLE BOSS drifting slightly to the outside, was given his cue a second time and responded willingly, splitting a pair en route to taking over the advantage, kicked away, crossing the wire hand urged. UPTOWN JOE kept watch on the pacesetter from the pocket, got angled outward after leaving the five-sixteenths pole, commenced the stretch three wide and driving, showed good energy while securing second. ENTHRONED was checked when becoming rank about a quarter into the race, raced three wide on the turn, entered the stretch and got set down, altered course towards the middle of the course nearing the eighth pole, closed in well belatedly for the show. FERLIN HUSKY broke alertly, maintained the early advantage and was quickly sent over to the rail, showed the way being rated to the five-sixteenths pole, had the primary pursuer, that being LITTLE BOSS, get asked for some run at that station and followed suit, spun into the stretch locked up in a fight with the previously-mentioned foe, offered good resistance as others joined in the battle for the front before relinquishing past the sixteenth pole. LITTLE BOSS prompted the pace from the two path, was asked for some run leaving the midway point on the turn, vied with vigor but failed to claim the advantage, drifted out slightly with a sixteenth remaining, inadvertently opening up window of opportunity for the winner, weakened steadily thereafter. SUMMER COVE three wide entering the turn, swung five wide exiting it, tired. GABRIEL'S FLAME saved ground to no avail. DISTANT THOUGHTS hesitated at the start, saved ground for most of the way down the backstretch, but chose the two path for the run around the bend, trailed throughout.
