Footnotes

AS WELL three wide at the top of the turn, came five wide into the stretch, gobbled up real estate readily leaving the eighth pole, rolled by the front runners roughly a sixteenth later to prove best. UMAN CANDY mostly three wide on the turn, bumped lightly with QUIET KISS turning for home, with EDDY'S TIME in close proximity to the inside, settled into her best stride in the final furlong and came home in a willing manner to procure the place. DONE SMOKING contently tracked the front runners while sitting in the pocket, was caught in traffic starting from the five-sixteenths marker, turned for home with no improvement in the situation, slipped off the rail in midstretch, gaining some but less than optimal racing clearance, altered course to the outside a sixteenth down the road to now be sufficiently in the clear, was given her cue and finished with interest. AMBER MORNING along the inside, felt pressure from another pair parked to her outside, arrived at the quarter pole with a slew of hot pursuers giving chase, clung desperately to the narrowest of leads before relinquishing with about a sixteenth left. QUIET KISS unleashed a four wide run from midpoint on the turn, made light contact with the second place finisher as they spun into the stretch abreast of each other, flattened out. EDDY'S TIME sat well rated and well placed from between rivals behind the contested pace, commenced the stretch wedged in between rivals, was herded out a bit by another foe in deep stretch while appearing to lack a solid closing response. CHOW FUN underwent a three wide journey, vied for the lead as the outermost of three for a good portion of the initial three-quarters, kept up the pursuit in earnest until midstretch before backing away. LEFT UPPERCUT fought for the lead from between rivals on the full turn and gave way. MUSIC MAID three wide to four wide for the opening six furlongs, folded.
