SWEETSOUTHERNSAINT, close up outside while in hand, raced four wide on the turn, dug in courageously in the stretch and was up late from the outside after a rousing finish. ALAWAL raced close up inside, dug in determinedly in the stretch, reached the front in deep stretch and stayed on gamely but could not resist the winner. SAID ENOUGH quickly showed in front, set the pace along the inside, took a clear lead past the eighth pole but faltered late. ERRANT ESCORT, outrun early, rallied wide and finished well. FLORESCENT HALO put in a three wide run on the turn but had little left for the stretch drive. COME ON NOW SEAN had no response when roused. ORDAINED chased the pace while three wide and tired. EXASPERATING stopped after a half mile.
