QUEEN AMIRA (GB) was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and finished gamely outside. WILLSHEFIRE chased the pace along the inside and dug in stubbornly in the stretch. EGYPT LANE was bumped at the start, raced inside and finished well. DINNER BREAK was outrun early, raced inside and was going well late. HONORING CAROLYN raced three wide and tired.
