SANGRE FRIO checked in tight at the start, trailed for a half, made a strong move along the rail to reach contention in midstretch then finished well while slipping through on the fence to get up in the final strides. CAPTAIN RIO set a pressured pace in the two path into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. TRIGGER'S MISSILE pressed the pace between horses into upper stretch, exchanged bumps with REDDING COLLIERY while battling heads apart into midstretch and yielded late. SCHNEERSON was reserved early, raced behind a wall of horses while in traffic at the quarter pole and rallied belatedly. REDDING COLLIERY waited along the inside while boxed in on the turn, raced behind horses lacking room in upper stretch, exchanged bumps with TRIGGER'S MISSILE while attempting to split rivals in midstretch, clipped heels and stumbled a sixteenth out then steadied in deep stretch. CHARLOTT HUMOR failed to mount a serious rally. PERFECT EASTER stalked five wide for a half and tired. PRINCE CHARMING chased four wide between horses and gave way. Following a stewards inquiry into the stretch run there was no change in the order of finish.
