INTERPATATION opened a clear advantage soon after the start, set the pace in hand under mild pressure along the backstretch, dug in when challenged nearing the quarter pole, relinquished the lead to GIO PONTI nearing the furlong marker then fought back gamely along the inside to edge clear in the final seventy yards. GIO PONTI was well placed in the two path along the backstretch, raced in the middle of the pack for a mile, rapidly closed the gap on the turn, lodged a bid three wide to challenge at the quarter pole, surged to the front in upper stretch, maintained a slim lead leaving the marker but couldn't stay with the winner through the final sixteenth. TELLING was outrun along the rail for a good part of the way, swung four wide while gaining on the turn, lugged in bothering GRAND COUTURIER in upper stretch then finished willingly to gain a share. Following a claim of foul by the rider of GRAND COUTURIER, TELLING was disqualified from third and placed fourth for interference through the stretch. GRAND COUTURIER (GB) raced well back for a mild, gained a bit on the turn, steadied and altered course to the outside in upper stretch and rallied mildly. AL KHALI pressed the winner in the two path to the turn and gave way. MUSKETIER (GER) raced just off the pace along the rail for seven furlongs and steadily tired thereafter.
