KID KATE bumped at the start with AILALEA about two strides out of the gate, recovered in short order and rushed up into a forward spot under her own power, contently tracked the early leader before advancing forward a second time, coming to the five-eighths pole, raced head to head with FREUD'S NOTEBOOK around the turn, with the rider keeping something in reserve all the while, inched away from that aforementioned rival nearing the quarter pole, with an additional pair by now in close proximity and gearing up for the stretch drive, spurted away during the ensuing furlong after having been let out a notch, then dug in with good determination to fend off two late-closing rivals to preserve the decision. AILALEA ducked inward enough at the break to initiate contact with KID KATE, dropped back soon after displaying no early speed, began to narrow her way back into contention taking the inside route down the backstretch, was guided off the rail at the half mile pole, continued to bide her time for the next eighth, swung wide into the lane, commencing to rally in earnest, placed widest of all in the seven path at the head of the stretch, closed with good energy down the outside of the strip to garner place honors. BEAUTICIAN reserved for nearly six furlongs, chose to fan five wide into the lane, rather than tempt fate trying to split between any of the foursome spread out in front just ahead of her, turning for home, then closed willingly during the stretch run en route for the show. BAHAMA BOUND unhurried during the opening half, entered contention with a four wide sweep on the turn and held well to the end. QUIET GIANT forwardly placed, made a three wide bid at the three-eighths pole, backed off after entering the stretch. TOUCHING BEAUTY raced along the outside and tired. FREUD'S NOTEBOOK grabbed the early lead a few jumps out of the gate, was joined by the top one nearing the five-eighths pole, raced on even terms with that foe until upper stretch and gave way.
