WISE STOP was lightly urged from the starting gate to grab the early lead, was placed under rating tactics once well in control, showed the way on a loosely-contested lead from the two path, remained on hold until nearing the three-sixteenths pole, left the furlong grounds still in control, then held sway while remaining under active handling to the finish line. SLEVIN coaxed along chasing the leader three wide, was asked for more turning for home, continued on willingly during the stretch drive, but had to settle for place honors. SIX FLINGS saved ground throughout, was set down approaching the five-sixteenths pole but proved no match for the top twosome. CITIFEST four wide around the turn, was put to a prolonged drive and had no rally. HOT MONEY raced along the outside and failed to reach a contending position. CHERNOBYL'S HERO off the inside, was no menace. GOOD CARD three wide, never factored. MOR CHANCES trailed.
