GIUSEPPINA lightly coaxed along prompting the pacesetter, ranged up to that foe during the run around the bend, took over nearing the quarter pole, with the rider keeping in reserve all the while, spurted away after being strongly roused at the three-sixteenths pole and held sway while being kept busy. TRUTH WILL TELL unhurried along the inside during the opening half, was eased outward at the half mile pole, advanced steadily into contention, swung four wide into the lane and came home with good energy to be clearly second best. STRATEGIC SUE reserved off the rail within good striking distance, came three wide into the stretch, was set down after settling into the stretch, gave chase but was outfinished during the stretch drive. CRIMSON TEMPEST broke behind the field after lunging at the break, took the inside route, slipped outward after entering the turn, angled five wide into the stretch and outfinished mainly weak and tired rivals for the last major share. GLORY WIT A STORY bumped at the start, raced three wide and tired. SOO'S PURSE bobbled at the break, remained forwardly placed for three-quarters before giving way. WHY THEN rated towards the inside setting the fractions for six furlongs, faltered. T

RAE bumped after the start, was no menace. CLAP HANDS four wide, was through after going a half. CIMINELLA was never involved. SHAHADAROBA bumped at the start, was urged along on the turn to keep pace, and folded.
