TIZWAY patiently prompted the leader from the outside, while placed under a good hold, ranged up to that opponent leaving the five-sixteenths pole, drew alongside by the time he reached the quarter pole, responded well when called upon in upper stretch, emerged from the furlong grounds with a clear advantage and maintained it while being kept busy to the end. COOL COAL MAN patiently tracked the front runners while saving ground during the run around the bend, angled outward turning for home and came home willingly to take the place. JERSEY TOWN bobbed at the break, vied for the lead along the inside, was put to a stern test nearing the top of the stretch, offered good resistance until midstretch, weakened steadily thereafter. CAIXA ELETRONICA quickly angled over to the rail soon after the start, was guided to the outside at the half mile pole, took up chase until upper stretch and gave way. LE GRAND CRU was through after completing three-quarters. REGAL RANSOM stalked three wide, was roused on the turn and backed off. MYTHICAL POWER trailed.
