DIVADORA was unhurried while parked out in the four path for nearly a half, was put to some encouragement to challenge in earnest from between rivals spinning into the lane, fought her way to a narrow advantage by the end of the furlong grounds, remained placed between opponents for another sixteenth, shook free and edged away, kept to a drive. ROCK N COZY got bumped from between rivals at the start, was forwardly placed while taking the overland route around the turn, continued on with good courage down the stretch to garner the place. CAPE COD CAROL bumped from both sides at the break, chased the disputed pace from the outside, ducked over to the inside coming to the five-sixteenths pole, unleashed a rail run from that station to loom a serious threat by upper lane, flattened out late. NINE LOVES was bumped between rivals at the start, pressed the issue three wide on the turn, kept up that pursuit until midstretch before weakening. ISLARAMA off slowly, darted over to the inside, was asked for some run by midpoint on the turn, vacated the rail and angled outward a sixteenth later, made no headway on the front runners. BONITA SONATA off a bit awkwardly, ducked inward, had the rider try to pull away from the nearest opponent, was unsuccessful and made light contact with ROCK N COZY, dropped back to last, appearing a bit slow to settle into stride, raced along the outside, picked up the pace during the later stages of the run around the turn, failed to have an impact. HUNDRED ACRE WOOD made solid contact with the rivals breaking from both sides of her, underwent a three wide pursuit, folded. ALL MINE TONIGHT departed the backstretch from the three path, was no factor.
