Footnotes

SHANKOPOTAMUS hustled from the gate, was placed to light urging once establishing the front from just off the inside, got let out at the quarter pole, drew away through the stretch under a drive to prevail. SO SCOTT settled towards the rear, came under light coaxing prior to being fully engaged by the rider at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide in upper stretch, kicked home down the center of the course with good late energy for the place honors while never threatening the top. DAN AND SHEILA off a beat slow, came under hustling to be forwardly placed, ranged up five wide in close range of the leader by midway on the turn, came under urging at that juncture, spun four wide into the lane, offered up a mild kick through the stretch for the show honors. MINESCAPE just off the inside towards the rear, came under a prolonged drive from the seven-sixteenths, offered up a mild bid in upper stretch before flattening out late on inside the final sixteenth while holding for the last major share. PROFESSOR FATE tracked the pace from close range, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the lane, remained in contention until the final eighth before weakening late on. CHARLIE'S QUEST four wide in close pursuit from between foes in the turn, came under a ride at the three-eighths pole, kicked on until straightening for home and weakened in the lane. CLASSIC R AND B three wide towards the rear, came under a long drive from the seven-sixteenths, cornered five to six wide in upper stretch and offered no response. POINT TAKEN chased the front urged along in midpack just off the inside, shifted five wide at the quarter pole and tired. CLIP THE COUPONS three wide in close pursuit, came under urging at the half mile pole, retreated after chasing for a half, then was eased nearing the eighth pole.
