BELLE OF THE HALL sat reserved from a considerable distance from off the inside down the backstretch, continued as the widest of all around the turn, left the three-eighths pole from the four path and ranged up into contention, got called upon turning for home, appeared to have been staved off until nearing the sixteenth marker, settled into her best stride at that station and began to gobble up real estate with much more success, overhauled AGAVE KISS with about seventy yards to go and edged away under good handling. AGAVE KISS came away with no apparent mishap and grabbed the early advantage, sat entrenched in the two path, well rated and loosely-contested, while setting the opening splits, was put to a hard drive spinning into the lane, added to the lead, albeit only by a bit during the ensuing furlong, felt pressure for the initial time once the top one made her presence with about a sixteenth remaining, got collared and had to settle for the place award. CATINATREE saved ground until upper stretch, was under a drive cutting the corner into the lane, proved no match. MILDLY OFFENSIVE got off awkwardly, lunging at the break, took up the role of being main pursuer departing the backstretch, stalked the runner up three wide with the pilot applying rating tactics, got called upon heading for the top of the lane, showed no response at all during the initial portion of the stretch drive, then backed away while being unmasked in the late stages.
