ZLOTY three wide for much of the way around the opening bend, sped enough rivals to tuck into the two path by the top of the backstretch, was patiently handled stalking the pacesetter making her way to the half mile pole, picked up interest and cruised up towards the front runners from the three path, making up the ground even though the tempo had greatly picked up, made her presence felt and challenged for the lead as the third fraction was being set, turned for home still in the fight for the front and was let out, overtook KNACQUE with about a sixteenth remaining and edged away. FINGERS CROSSED reserved in the two path for the opening three-quarters, swung four wide into the lane, got straightened away and came home with good energy down the center of the course to procure the place. CROWN QUEEN acted up in the gate, proceeded to come away a bit sluggishly, raced from off the inside throughout, was in the four path entering the far turn and in the fifth one exiting it, finished willingly to earn the show award. KNACQUE broke well and took command during the run around the first turn, was guided over to the hedge, got rated while showing the way on a loosely-contested lead for almost six furlongs, felt an up tick in the pressure coming to the five-sixteenths pole by being challenged by another pair parked to her outside, and was soon let out in response to it, battled with them until deep into the furlong grounds, then went one on one with the winner for next sixteenth before relinquishing and steadily backing away. ALDARA attended the pacesetter from the two path, well rated during the initial stages, narrowed the gap until directly alongside the leader, with the eventual winner just off her hind quarters coming to five-sixteenths marker, vied from rivals from that station to the eighth pole, tired. HOLABIRD hung out three wide on the first turn, was closer to the inside on the subsequent one, spun four wide into the stretch, drifted inward and was along the hedge shortly afterwards, faltered. STATUS saved ground early, was three wide by the top of the far turn and five wide at the top of lane, had no response. MONSERRAT raced along the outside and was through after going six furlongs. SUNSET RIDE was taken hold after ducking over towards the temporary rail and the gap that lay beyond it, saved ground early and failed to menace.
