BREATHAWAY chased the front runners from the two path, was sent over to the rail in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths marker, was still along it turning for home under some encouragement, angled out sharply with about an eighth to go, grabbed a slim advantage and dug in well to preserve it. HOOKED FOREVER unhurried, picked up interest after the half had been completed, swung four wide into upper stretch, was in the midst of a rally when herded out momentarily by the winner past the eighth pole, finished with good courage for the place. SLIMSHADY rode the rail, was already under a drive cutting the corner into the stretch, altered course towards the middle of the strip with a furlong remaining and continued onward willingly en route for the show. MISSISSIPPI DUEL argued for command from the inside, drifted into two path for the start of the drive home, held on well before overhauled in the final furlong. PROFESSOR CHAOS raced from off the inside, mustered up a mild response to mainly improve position. UNCLE MITCHO pulled rankly on the bit while proceeding down the backstretch, angled off the inside route at the quarter pole, stayed in contention for another furlong then backed away. KNOCK QUIETLY placed three wide at the head of the stretch, had little left to offer. CAPTAIN GAUGHEN dueled for command from the outside and gave way.
