DAVID broke alertly and set the pace from the outside while in hand, put away HEARTS AT RISK approaching the stretch, turned back EWER ALL WET in upper stretch then drew clear and was kept to a drive to remain clear to the wire. EWER ALL WET, close up outside early while in hand, advanced three wide on the turn, took a run at the winner entering the stretch but could not get by that rival while easily best of the other contestants. HEARTS AT RISK broke running and pressed DAVID for the lead while along the rail then tired approaching the stretch. IRON PYRITE, rated along inside on the backstretch, came wide nearing the stretch but had no response when roused. CHEVAL BLANC chased the pace while three wide and tired after the opening half mile. GANDER dropped back after the start and was always outrun.
