PSYCHOTIC REACTION was outrun early, rallied four wide approaching the stretch, responded to steady pressure and was along in the final strides. SOUTHACK was outrun early, raced three wide, rallied outside and just missed after his rider lost her whip in the drive. RAPPERS DEELITE was hustled to the front, set the pace along the inside, took a clear lead into deep stretch and faltered. MUMBLES chased the pace along the inside and lacked a rally. HONEST EXPECTATION was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and offered a mild rally outside. MAASTRICHT chased the pace while three wide and tired. GOLDEN TRIESTE bobbled at the start, chased the pace from the outside and tired. BRIGHT WEEKEND had no response when roused.
