HE'S A PIONEER was outrun early, rallied inside on the turn, split rivals in the stretch and prevailed under a drive. KARAKORUM TUXEDO chased the pace while between rivals and dug in gamely to the finish. CHAMP SAFI was outrun early, put in a three wide run nearing the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. SINKWICH was hustled out to a clear lead, set the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. FLY SO FAR dropped far back early and showed some interest late. DASHBOARD DRUMMER chased the pace while three wide and tired. FEROCIOUS WON tired after a half mile.
